

The NR Hunter Derby

In the two-round format, the open numerical system to score competitors in the Classic Hunter Round (first round) on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality and substance, and movement. In addition, the base score in the Handy Hunter Round (second round) reflects brilliance of pace and handiness.

In each round, after the judges' base score is given, one point will be added for each highoption fence jumped up to a maximum of four. The point must be added even if there is a refusal, rail down or or loss of good jumping style at that fence, providing that the horseand-rider combination does jump the higher height fence option.

Obstacles are reminiscent of the hunt field and must offer a variety of appearances, such as natural post and rail, stone wall, white board fence or gate, coop, aiken, hedge, oxer, brush, logs and natural foliage. The Handy Hunter Round should simulate riding over hunt country and incorporate options such as tight turns, clever options for jump approaches, hand galloping and trotting a fence.


Fence heights will be set at 2'6", with four high option fences set at 3'.

Derby Incentive:

Nominate your horse for \$30. This will go into a fund for the Derby Finals that will be held at our September Horse show. Nominated horses will pay \$40 to compete in the NR Derby Class, non-nominated horses will pay \$50.

You must COMPLETE the course at ONE horse show to qualify for the year end Payout at the NR DERBY FINALS in September.

The more that participate the bigger the prize money! (Does not affect year end high point awards.)

Join the competition by nominating your horse for the September NR Jumper Cup and the NR Hunter Derby Finals!

Table II, Sec. 2 (a)—The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. In the event of equality of faults after the first round, there will be one jump-off for first place only in which time will decide in the event of equality of faults.

Table II, Sec. 2 (b)—The first round and first jump-off, if any, are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. If a competitor has gone clear in the first round, the competitor will, without leaving the ring, upon an audible signal, commence the designated jump- off course.

Table II, Sec. 2 (c)—Two Phase Competitions (Power and Speed)- The first phase to consist of 8 to 10 jumping efforts and the second phase of 5 to 7 jumping efforts. Scores are decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed if any. If a competitor has gone clear in the first phase, he will, upon crossing the finish line, commence the second phase course. Time starts as the horse crosses the finish

Table II, Sec. 1— Time First Round. The first round is decided by adding together the faults incurred over the course and any penalties for exceeding the Time Allowed. Horses with clear rounds or equal faults are classified according to their time taken to complete the course.

Riders will return for a flat phase. Riders are to show at a working walk, collected trot sitting, working trot rising, working trot demonstrating a lengthening of stride, working canter, collected canter, working canter demonstrating a lengthening of stride and counter canter. Riders may be asked to perform advanced flatwork including but not limited to, turn on the haunches, shoulder-in and leg yielding.

Best Equitation Rider Award donated by: TAPS (Classes 14 - 16) Winner will be chosen by the Judge, as the rider that exemplifies the true meaning of Equitation and Sportsmanship. Must enter all Open Eq classes to be eligible for the Best Equitation Rider. Points do not count.
